



## STUDENT DRESS CODE

Students must comply with the NSU College of Pharmacy dress code while on campus from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday thru Friday, *including examination periods and school holiday periods*. This includes wearing your white lab coats while on campus, in labs, and at your experiential sites. This applies to all students even if you may not be attending class on a specific day but are on campus during those days and times specified above.

When conducting business with the College of Pharmacy administrative offices, students must always appear in dress code. **Students not in compliance can be denied admittance to class or asked to leave a class for violation of any of these policies. Repeated violations will be considered improper professional behavior and may result in disciplinary action (2008-2009 COP Student Handbook).**



**Acceptable:** White clinical jacket at all times;  
Matching scrub sets and shoes;  
Professional business dress: Men: Shirt, tie, slacks, and regular shoes;  
Women: slacks, pants, or skirt with blouse, or dress and appropriate shoes.

**Unacceptable:** Jeans, shorts, cut-offs, mini-skirts (higher than mid-thigh), see-through clothing or halter tops; beach/flip-flop sandals or thong footwear; t-shirts (as the outer shirt); jogging or exercise clothing; hats or caps, unless of a religious nature.
