



COP Student Tutor Program

The Student Tutor Program provides students with academic support via on-line live classroom, in addition to support provided by faculty and administration. Live classroom is an online, interactive, tutor-led learning environment. It allows students and tutors to interact using voice, video, application sharing, polling, digital tablets and white boarding. Online tutoring, also known as e-tutoring is flexible and unique is increasing in popularity as the tutoring choice students and professionals.

All P1 and P2 students have access to the on-line tutoring classroom. It is a **free** service provided to students enrolled in the College of Pharmacy at NSU. Subject areas covered include Anatomy & Physiology, Biochemistry, Dynamics, and Microbiology among others.

Tutoring sessions are held weekly and schedules are posted in the Web CT COP Tutoring Classroom.

Student tutors are confidential support resources for students. Student tutors have prior tutoring experience or are in the top 15% of their class academically.

In addition, Rho Chi members volunteer their time on alternate Saturdays to assist students. Information on dates and times will be sent out via email and students are required to sign up for this live tutoring. If students do not sign up Saturday tutoring will be cancelled.
