

Student Tutor Program

The Student Tutor Program provides students with academic support via on-line live classroom, in addition to support provided by faculty and administration. Live classroom is an online, interactive, tutor-led learning environment. It allows students and tutors to interact using voice, video, application sharing, polling, digital tablets and white boarding. Online tutoring, also known as e-tutoring is flexible and unique is increasing in popularity as the tutoring choice students and professionals.

Students who are on academic probation or experiencing academic difficulty are automatically added to the Web CT tutoring program. Any other student may request to be added to on-line tutoring. On-line tutoring is a **free** service provided to students enrolled in the College of Pharmacy at NSU.

Tutoring sessions are held weekly and schedules are posted in Web CT.

Student tutors are confidential support resources for students. Student tutors have prior tutoring experience or are in the top 15% of their class academically.

Instructor Requirements

- 256 MB RAM (higher recommended)
- Broadband Internet access
- Soundcard with a microphone and speakers
