I understand that I am required to attend all classes and each cultural exploration as outlined in the Summer Study Abroad Program. Mandatory attendance is required to successfully complete the program.

Students shall report to the NSU-COP study abroad faculty, in writing, reason for all absences Prior to the program activity within four hours of each occurrence. No student shall have more than 4 approved excused absences for the entire program, except for extenuating circumstances requiring a doctor's note e.g. extended illness, hospitalization, etc. Each session will count as a separate absence, i.e. morning session, afternoon session, evening cultural exploration session. Therefore, one full day's absence will count as 3 excused absences. Due to the function of the group travel package, all culture exploration tours in China and Japan are required mandatory attendance. Unexcused absences may result in a student failing the course, and result in sanctions including probation, suspension or dismissal. Any student failing a course does so at his or her own expense.

The University reserves the right to take disciplinary action for violations of the Code of Student Conduct and Academic Responsibility and university policies and procedures, even when they occur off campus.

I understand that I will be subject to all rules, regulations, and requirements as to conduct, academic and financial policies of NSU as stated in the *2008 NSU Student Handbook*.

Students are responsible for compliance with all public laws. Any act that could constitute a violation of public laws will establish cause for legal and/or disciplinary action by the university. I understand NSU reserves the right to withdraw any student on account of unsatisfactory academic performance or unacceptable behavior.
