

HOW TO ACCESS VIDEOTAPED LECTURES

To review a class that you missed or did not understand, you may do so by following these instructions.

You need to have a broadband connection (e.g., DSL, Cable, etc.) to watch the video. You may access the classes in the microcomputer labs but please bring headphones to avoid bothering the other students.

If you are accessing from outside the NSU network:

1. Go to the URL: <http://www.nova.edu/help/internet/vpn>
2. Download and save the appropriate VPN client for your operating system. If you have done this in the past, you do not need to do this again. Instructions for downloading and configuring the client are available by clicking Configuration Information or by going to :

3. If you have trouble, please contact the NSU Help Desk at 1-800-356-0026 ext. 4357.
4. To connect to the NSU network, click the SecureClient icon in the system tray and choose Connect. (Try right-clicking on the icon if clicking it does not bring up the connection screen). Enter your NSU email login and password and click Connect. You are now connected to the NSU network.

If you are accessing from within the NSU network, start here:

5. Now open your browser and connect to the Starbak machine at:
<http://137.52.20.19/>
From the Drop Down List, choose your class
Click the Continue button
Choose the lecture you are interested in. You may sort the lists by name or date.
On the next screen, choose the Quicktime logo (looks like a clock) next to Audio/Video.

Please note: you may need to install Quicktime if it is not already installed on your computer. Quicktime is a free download available at <http://www.apple.com/quicktime/download/>
