

Pharm.D. / M.B.A. Dual Degree Program

Program Eligibility

- M.B.A. with any Major
- Open to Pharm.D. students interested in learning management principles to manage their own private practice or other business opportunity
- Students in the dual degree program must receive a letter from the College of Pharmacy Dean or designee approving the dual program
- Once approved the student is not required to submit an HCBE application
- Students pursuing the Pharm.D. degree can apply to do a concurrent degree after successful completion of first-year pharmacy coursework
- Students who have already completed their Pharm.D. degree are not entitled to the HCBE course exemption

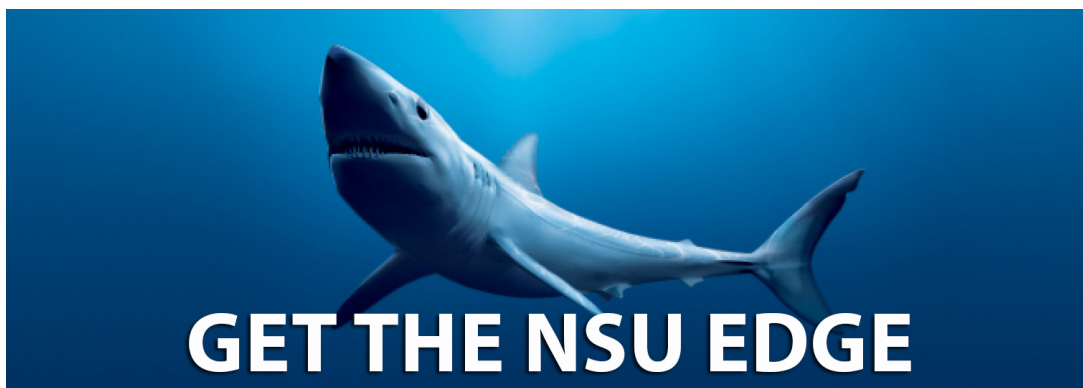
