The program's focus will be on traditional Chinese medicine.

Development and manufacture of Chinese medicines  
Learn about the practices of acupuncture, moxibustion, and tuina

Chinese Medicine Museum, Herbs Planting Center, Tablet Factory  
Beijing University of Chinese Medicine and Xi'an Jiaotong University  
The Acupuncture and Tuina Center of Chengdu University  
Cultural activities in the Chinese cities of Beijing, Xian, Chengdu, Leshan, Shanghai, and in Tokyo, Japan
